



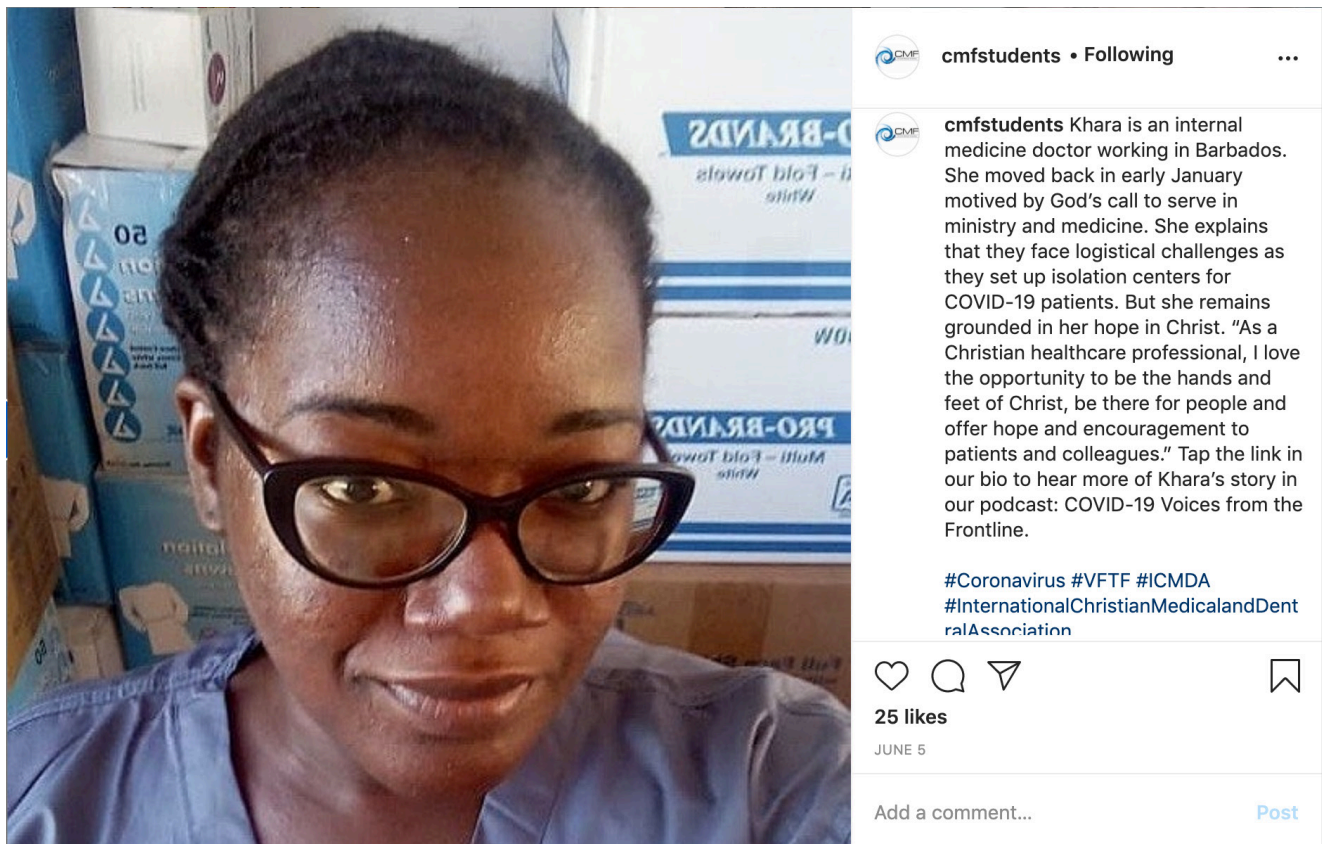

I worked alongside staff from Christian Medical Fellowship (CMF) UK for the whole month of May to create posts for *Instagram*. These posts repurposed content CMF staff created had originally created for publications, their website and for a podcast. The goal for these posts was to demonstrate how to do this and provide extra hands for their already stretched communications team during a

stressful period in the COVID-19 pandemic.

CMF provided me with photographs, transcripts and other source materials, and then I created the posts, scheduled them on a *Later* account I set up for them, and also created and populated a *linkin.bio* page. 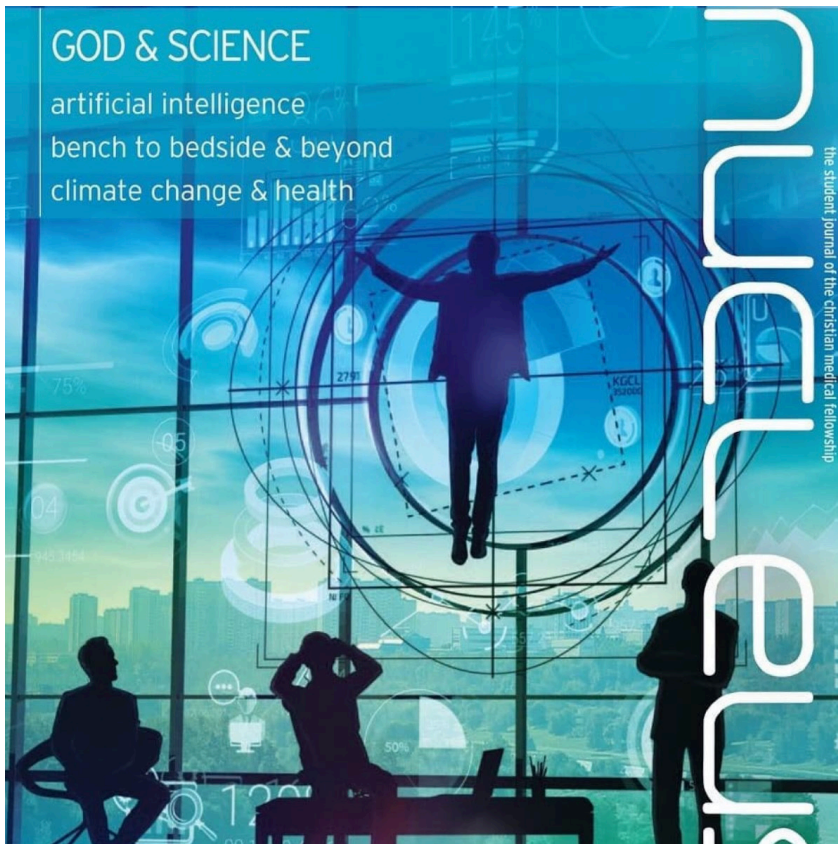

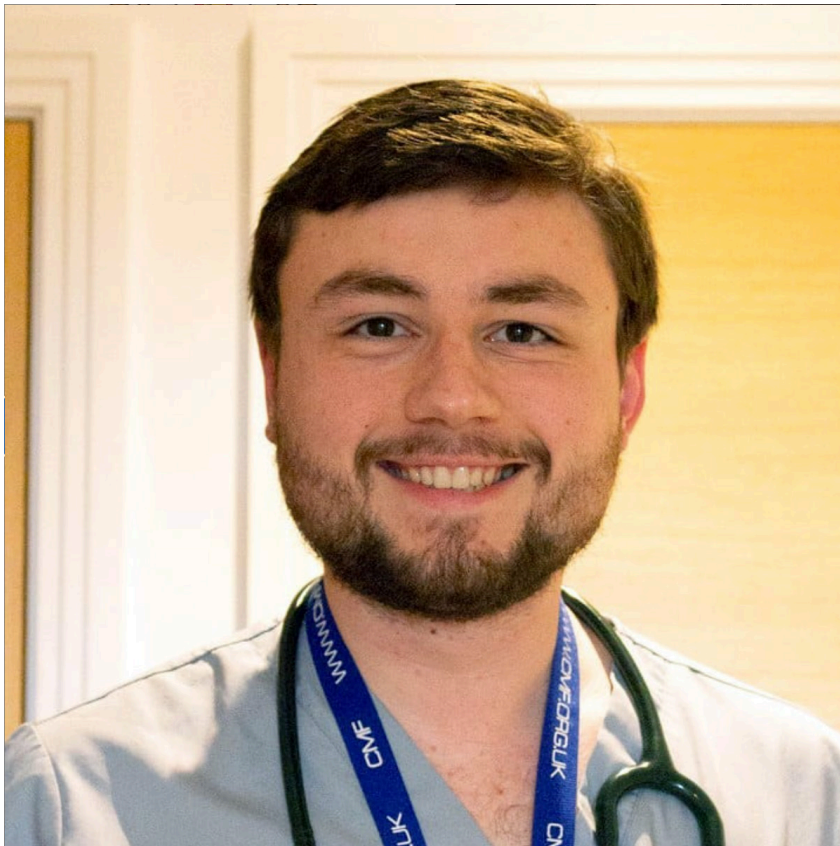

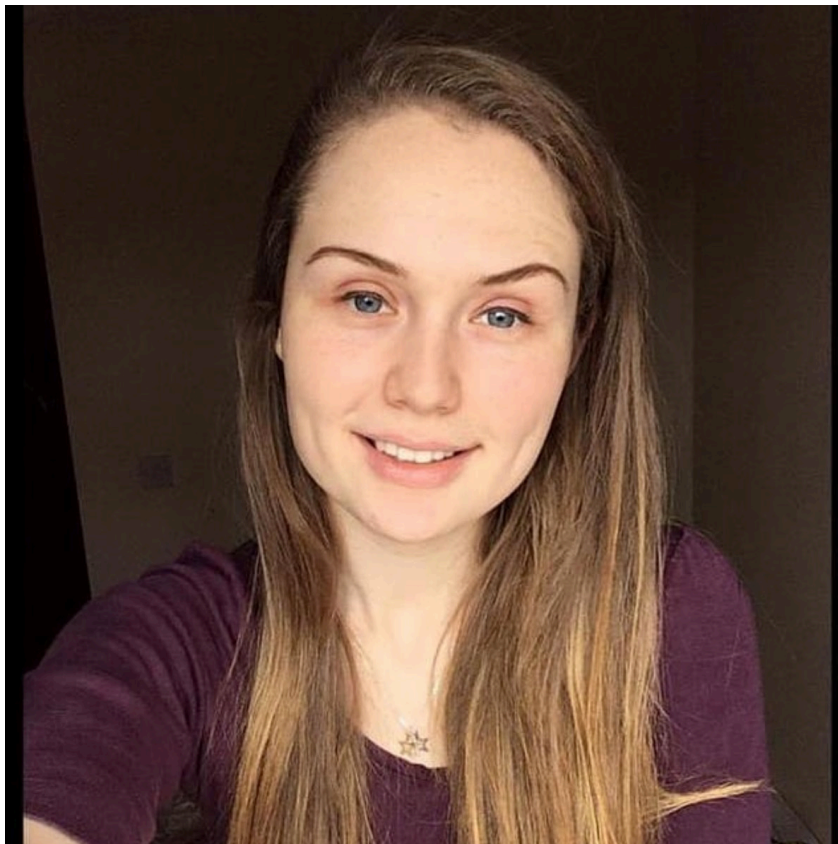
